1. Presentation of clubs (submitting withdrawals and changes) on Friday 22nd May 2009 from 12:00 to 14:00 in the conference room at SC Račice
Withdrawals and changes can be submitted during the presentation.
2. A preliminary schedule will be published on www.ceskeveslovani.cz.
A more detailed schedule will be available and displayed on the organiser's notice board after the draw on Friday 22nd May 2009.
3. On Saturday all the races will take place according to the programme as heats for the Sunday A and B finals.
In the event of over 24 boats a C final will be included.
In the event of over 30 boats a D final will be included.
On Saturday 23rd May 2009 the races will start at 08:30.
On Sunday 24th May 2009 the races will start at 8:30.
Saturday semi-finals begin an hour after the race of junior Eights.
4. If there are over 36 boats entered, qualification races will take place on Friday with the fastest 36 boats qualifying for Saturday's heats.
5. In the event of **19 – 36 boats** semi-finals will take place on Saturday 23rd May 2009 one hour after the start of the last junior race.

Progress to semi-final: 4 heats (qualify 3 + 3 + 3 + 3)

Races JWB + JWB (age 15 – 16) are running according to Czech Rowing Association rules.
